Chapter 1 — Punctuation that matters

You don't need every punctuation rule to write well — you need a handful, used confidently. This book focuses on the marks that change meaning and clarity.

- **Full stops.** End complete thoughts. Two thoughts jammed together with a comma is the most common error.
- **Commas.** Separate items and set off extra information — not to join two full sentences.
- **Apostrophes.** Show possession (the dog's bowl) or contraction (it's = it is). Not for plurals.
