Chapter 1 — The analytical paragraph (T.E.E.L)

The analytical paragraph is the single most useful structure in high school English. Master it, and every essay body paragraph becomes a repeatable, markable unit.

- **Topic sentence.** State the point of the paragraph — your mini-argument.
- **Evidence + Explain.** Quote briefly, then analyse how the technique proves your point.
- **Link.** Tie back to the question and lead into the next idea.
