SAMPLE LESSON

Chapter 1 — Show, don't tell

Weak writing tells the reader what to think. Strong writing shows them, and lets them feel it. This single shift lifts writing from ordinary to memorable.

- **Telling.** 'She was nervous.' The reader is informed, but nothing is felt.
- **Showing.** 'Her hands would not stay still, and she read the same line three times.' Now the reader feels it.
- **Choose detail.** One precise, telling detail beats three vague adjectives.
